ledge, and thereof do clearly acquit & discharge him
the said Joseph Fowler his heirs, and have bargained
and sold and by these Presents in plain and open Market
according to our form of law bargain sell set over
and deliver unto him the said Joseph Fowler, all
Singular my house hold furniture, & also one Bay
horse three years old branded on the near ~~the~~ side
E. to have and to hold unto the s^d. Joseph Fowler & to his
heirs and assigns and singular the hereby bargained
premises unto his and their own proper use & behoof
forever, only with following limitation, that is to say

In case the said Joseph Fowler of Laurence County
my heirs &c. from the date hereof will & truly pay
unto the s^d. Joseph Fowler of Greenville County, his heirs
the aforesaid sum of thirty five Dollars in the space
of ten days, then & above will be null and void
or other wise to remain in full force, and then the
s^d. Joseph Fowler of Laurence County myself my heirs
&c. the said bargained premises unto him the said
Joseph Fowler of Greenville County his heirs &c. will war-
rant and for ever defend by these presents. In Witness
