James Harrison of Greenville District in the State aforesaid All that Tract of Land originally Surveyed for John Machon and granted to me the said John Wickly on the fourth day of September 1786. by his excellency W^m. Moultrie containing Six hundred Acres, be the same more or less lying in said State and District on Branches of Healy River bounded by lines running N. 30 E. 35 on Corners land S 70 E 23. N. 25 E 82 on W^m. Whites land, S 67 E 62 on vacant land, S 55 W 29 - S 35 E 14. S 50 W 16 - S 35 E 32 on Sam. Peairs land N 55 W 8 - W 14 - S 25 W 22 on Alexander's land, N 25 W 40. - S 81 W 64 on Jenkins land, Surveyed by James Seaborn Deputy Surveyor & Certified on the 12th of Aug^r. 1785. Together with all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Accidental or appertaining: To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned to the said Harrison his Heirs and assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned to the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns, and against every person or persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof: in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty eighth day of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred & two & of the independence of the United States - Signed Sealed and delivered in Presence of John Peoples, John Peoples, J.
