I know all men by these Presents that we John Mochan and Dyce Mochan his wife both of the State of Carolina and District of Greenville for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by John Lowell of the District aforesaid at and before the Sealing and delivery of these Presents ~~the receipt~~ ^{of} ~~the~~ ^{the} granted bargain or sold to lease and Confirmed unto the said John Lowell all that Plantation or tract of Land situate lying and being in the District aforesaid on Saluda River ^{& its branches} containing one hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less begining at the fence of Larkin Tarants on the Bank of Saluda River from thence on said fence to the Original Corner from thence to a small marked Hickory Station from thence a direct line to the back line of sth ~~part~~ ^{part} land from thence S. & S. W. on Lands of Mary Lowell, John Jones and Joseph Wood, thence on a new Conditional line to the said River from thence up the Meanders of said River to the Begining Corner. Together with all and singular the Rights Members hereditaments and appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said premises unto
