Anny Burns for and in consideration of the sum of eight
hundred dollars to us in hand paid by Larkin Tarrant
of South Carolina & District of Greenville hath bargained
sold aliend and Confirmed unto the said Larkin Tarrant
a certain Plantation or Tract of Land containing two hun-
dred & sixteen acres be the same more or less Situate
lying and being in the District aforesaid on the Waters
of Saluda River being part of a Tract Originally gran-
ted to James Blasingame Esq. bounded as follows be-
gining on a small White Oak on Perry's line, thence
N. W. 80. 25 to Perry's corner a Red Oak thence the
same course 20 to a Stake thence S. W. 30 - 40, 50 to a Stake
thence S. E. 80 - 50, 80 to a Stake on the Original line
thence N. E. 20 - 44 with the Original line to the Begin-
ing Corner, bounded on Sundry lands as will more fully
appear from the Original Grant, being the Tract we now
