consideration of the sum of One thousand dollars to
him in hand paid by Matthew Langford of the
District and State aforesaid have granted bargain
sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain
sell and release unto the said Matthew Langford his heirs
& assigns all that Tract or parcel of land containing
One hundred and fifty acres or the same more or less
lying on both sides of South Tyger river being in Green-
ville District it being part of a tract of land granted
to Rob^l Nelson Sr. by his Excellency William Moultrie
bearing date April the fourth 1785. beginning on a White
Oak in a Conditional line made between Robert Nelson
& Matthew Langford thence North 50 to the West to a
Stone Corner thence S. 55 to the W. to a White Oak corner.
thence W. 26 to a White Oak, thence S 40 W. 10 6. to a pine
thence S 60 E. to a poplar on the Conditional made, thence
