Shelton, Wm Snow & Elizabeth ~~Smith~~ Mathis, the said land lying on both sides of Laurel Creek supposed to be four hundred acres more or less. Together with all & singular the Rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or in any wise Incident or appertaining: To have & to hold all & singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said David Edwards his heirs and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defende all & singular the said Premises unto the said David Edwards his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
