This Indenture made this 30th Day of January in the year 1802.
 Between James Lewis of the one part, and John Shepherd of the other
 part. & both of the State of South Carolina. Greenville District. We stipulate
 that James Lewis of & in consideration of the sum of three hundred &
 Seventy four and one Quarter dollars to him in hand paid the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged hath bargained and sold and by these
 presents doth bargain and sell alien release and confirm unto John Shepherd
 for ever all that Tract Plantation or Parcel of Land containing two hundred
 & three & one Quarter acres, a part of Langley & Sandas Lands, lying on
 the head of Peter Creek, the waters of ^{Eponee} Sandy River, the said land is
 bounded by Samuel Lewis' land Isaac Towers land & Archibald Smiths land
 & John Shepherds land & James Gooches land, and the said James Lewis
 doth Covenant and agree to and with the said John Shepherd that the above
 described Tract of land is free from any manner of incumbrance
 whatsoever, and do the said James Lewis with for ever warrant & defend the
 said Tract or Plantation of "land" from all person or persons having any Right
 Title or claim thereunto, and all and every part thereof from himselfe his
 heirs executors, Administrators assigns or any other person or persons
 whatsoever trying just or lawful right title or claim thereunto, But
 to the proper use of the said John Shepherd his heirs Ex. or Adm. or assigns
