



Thence E 11. 25. to a Hickory thence S. 50. E. 40 to a Post Oak, thence S. 63 E 37  
 to a Red Oak, thence N 18 E 35 to a dead Red Oak, thence N. 35 E 15 to a B.  
 Sack, thence N 33 W 15 to a Stake, thence N 60 W 31. 50 to a Hickory stump  
 thence S 47 W. 25 to a White Oak on the creek, thence up the creek to the  
 beginning, as is represented by a plat & Resurvey by M. G. Salmon Esq.  
 & dated the 13<sup>th</sup> Feb. 1802, the original being land granted to John Clayton  
 James Vance and bettering and bounding as aforesaid; Together with all  
 and singular the premises and appurtenances therunto belonging or in  
 any wise appertaining with all and every the Estates rights, title, Interest  
 Claims and demands, rents issues and profits, clear of all incumbrances  
 Judgments Mortgages ~~etc~~, receipts Evidences or writings whatsoever  
 unto the said James Ross his heirs executors administrators & assigns to  
 the only use and behoof of him the said James Ross his heirs &c. w<sup>o</sup>;  
 Adm<sup>rs</sup> & assigns for ever; and he the said John Burk his heirs, exec<sup>rs</sup>  
 & adm<sup>rs</sup> shall and will warrant and for ever defend as well in Equity  
 as in Law all the aforesaid Tract of Three hundred and Seventy Nine  
 acres unto the s<sup>d</sup> James Ross his heirs Executors Administrators and  
 Assigns from all and every Person or persons laying any claim or  
 Claims lawfully to any parcel or part thereof. In Witness whereof the  
 said John Burk hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his Seal  
 this 7<sup>th</sup> day of March one thousand eight hundred and Three, and in  
 the twenty seventh year of Independence of the United States of America

 sell and release unto the said David Norris, a certain Tract or Parcel of  
 Land
