Coker. To have & to hold the above mentioned premises unto the said Francis Settle his heirs Executors & assigns for ever. and I the said Robert Redman do oblige myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and for ever defend the above mentioned premises unto the said Francis Settle his heirs Executors & assigns against the Claim of all persons whatsover. NOW if the said Robert Redman and his heirs Executors and Administrators do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Francis Settle his heirs Executors or Administrators the just the just and full sum of Twenty five pounds four shillings lawful money of Virginia on or before the first day of January 18 hundred and four for the redemption of the above mentioned premises then this present to be null and void other wise to remain in full force and virtue.
