Person of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in Consider-  
ation of the sum of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Robert Person  
of the District and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & Released  
and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the  
said Robert Person part of two Tracts of Land on both sides of  
the South fork of Enoree River, one of the Tracts originally granted  
to Robert Prince Heir at Law to Thomas Prince deceased by his  
Excellency Benjamin Guerard Esq. the fifteenth day of October one  
Thousand seven hundred and eighty four, the other granted to David  
Blackwell the fourth day of July One thousand seven hundred & eighty five  
by William Mouthie Esq. - Beginning at a Black Oak Corner in the  
Fork of a branch just above the old Bridge that is on said Branch, thence  
N. 72 E. 16 to a post oak corner, thence S. 10 E. 50 to a Stake, thence S. 5.  
W. 4. 50 links to a post oak corner, thence S. 76 W. 13 to a Black Oak cor-  
ner, thence S. 7. to a White Oak corner, thence N. 63 W. 8 to a post oak, thence N. 8 E  
along a line marked line to a Stake on the South bank of the Creek,  
thence down, the several meanders of said Creek to the mouth of a branch  
Mouthing in the North side of said Creek, thence up the said branch  
to the fork, thence to the beginning, Containing one hundred & fifty  
Acres more or less. Together with all and singular the rights mem-  
bers, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises before  
mentioned unto the said Robert Person his heirs and assigns  
For ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and  
Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular  
the said Premises to Robert Person his heirs and assigns against  
myself and my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claim-  
ing or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand  
and seal this 22<sup>d</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord  
1803. & in the twenty seventh year of the Independence of the United
