State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I William  
Savage of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration  
of the sum of one hundred ~~four~~ dollars to him paid by Young Griffins of the  
State and County aforesaid have bargained sold and released and by these  
Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Young Griffins a  
certain Tract or parcel of Land containing One hundred & fifty acres  
situate in the County of Greenville on the North side of Enoree River  
upon the Branches of said river and Broadam Creek. to wit. beginning at  
a Black Jack John Miller's corner thence along said Miller's line North  
42<sup>o</sup> 35' chains to a post Oak in Matthew Sparks line, thence along  
said line N 55<sup>o</sup> 2' W. 23<sup>o</sup> p. 50 links to a dead pine on said line, thence along  
a Conditional line of Land conveyed to Nancy Githutho. S 58<sup>o</sup> 2' W. 28' chains  
to a post. thence S 53<sup>o</sup> 2' W. 23' chains to a post Oak & then Eastward to the  
beginning - the same being part of a Tract of Land granted to said Savage  
the 25<sup>th</sup> June 1796. Containing 618 acres. Together with all & singular  
the Rights members hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or  
in any wise Incident or appertaining therunto. To have and to hold  
all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the s<sup>d</sup> Young  
Griffins his heirs and assigns for ever. And I ~~do hereby~~ the s<sup>d</sup> William  
Savage do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators  
to warrant & to waite defende all and singular the said Premises unto the  
s<sup>d</sup> Young Griffins him <sup>his</sup> heirs & assigns against the claim or claims of all  
other persons whomsoever claiming the same or any part of it lawfully  
As Witness my hand and seal this day of November in the Year  
of our Lord Christ One thousand eight hundred and one and in  
the 25<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the United States of America.
