

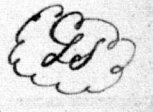

South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents that I Janus Gray of District and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by William Dill of Greenville District, I have granted bargained and sold & released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said William Dill a plantation or Tract of land lying in Greenville District on the Wild Cat Creek of South Tyger river containing Ninety four acres be the same more or less, beginning on a Stake a Corner of land surveyed for Joseph Dowdy, thence N. 45 to a post Oak Corner on Dowdy's land, thence N. 10 E. 13 to a Stake on land granted to Shaw, thence S 30, E 26, to a Stake Chestnut, thence S 70, W. 9 to a pine, thence S 34 E. 20 to a Stake on land surveyed for Brogdon, thence S 74 N. 29 to a Stake on land laid off to John Lewis, it being the beginning corner. Together with all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Dill his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors & admors to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said William Dill, his heirs and assigns for ever against myself & my heirs and against all and every other person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. In Witness whereof I the said Janus Gray have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this Seventeenth day of March in the year of our Lord, one thousand Eight hundred and three, being the twenty seventh year of the Independence of the United States of America signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us the Witnesses }
