



The State of South Carolina. We all men by these Presents that I Thomas Casley of Greenville County and State of South Carolina in consideration of one hundred dollars to me paid by John Blasingame of the County and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released, and by these Presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Blasingame, All that plantation or Tract of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less, Situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, and on the banks of Saluda River bounded all sides on vacant land at the time when surveyed, the said Tract being a part of a Tract of land granted to John Clayton by his excellency Benj. Guirard on the 20<sup>th</sup> day January 1785. beginning on a red oak, thence N. 20. W. to one fork of brushy Creek thence up the said Creek to the mouth of the Spring branch, thence up the said branch to a red Oak, thence along a line agreed on to William Townes which was laid out to John Clayton, thence from the said line to a Stake Corner, thence to the beginning. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all & singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said John Blasingame his heirs & assigns for ever. and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & for ever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said John Blasingame his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal this 23<sup>d</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety seven & in the 20<sup>th</sup> year of the Independence of the United States of America
