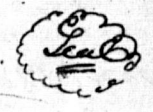

South Carolina Personally come John McHaffey before me and being duly sworn in due form of law and oath on said oath that he saw Benjamin Kilgore Junr. sign and as his rail act and deed deliver the above & within deed for the uses and purposes therein mentioned, also that John Moon and himself in Presence of each other subscribed their names as witnesses to the due execution of the same. Sworn to and subscribed before me this 5th of May 1802.

The State of South Carolina. Know all men by these Presents, that I Joseph Wilbanks of Greenville District in the State aforesaid. for and in consideration of Twenty two Pounds seven shillings and six pence to me in hand paid by James Kilgore of the State and District aforesaid. I have granted bargained and sold and by these Presents Do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Kilgore All that Tract or parcel of Lands containing sixty one acres be the same more or less, it being a part of a Tract of two hundred and fifty acres granted to James Rabb by Patent bearing date the thirty first day of August, one thousand seven hundred and seventy four and conveyed from the said James Rabb to said Joseph Wilbanks by lease and release bearing date the sixth day of October and the day following in the year 1785. Situate in the State and District aforesaid on the North side of Guilders creek and on both sides of Peters Creek, Beginning at Pipim on and State corner on the original line and runs through said Tract N. Eight and one half degrees to the West Sixty chains to a Maple Corner on the original line thence S 60 E 33 ch. to a Hickory corner also on James Whites line, thence on said line S 30 W. 48 chains to the Beginning, which includes the full lands to be conveyed, be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining: To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Kilgore his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant & forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said James Kilgore his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
