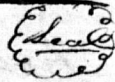

 aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars
 to me in hand paid by George Welch of the district and State aforesaid
 And granted bargained sold and released and by these Presents do
 grant bargain sell and release unto said George Welch Parcel
 of land containing one hundred acres to the same man or life
 it being a part of a certain Grant of Five hundred acres granted to
 Richard Brock Roberts by his excellency Wm. Moultrie Esq. about the
 Year 1785. Recorded in Grant book 0000 page 238. Situate on
 Rayburns Creek waters of Saluda river in district aforesaid, and
 conveyed to Wm. Welch, the said one hundred acres more or less
 Beginning on a Hickory ^{conditional} corner - on the N. side of said creek on a
 line of said tract, bounded by Andrew Cooper, lands, running N.
 80 W. 36 ch. 50 to a red oak corner, thence N. 5 W. 28 ch. to a red oak
 corner, bounded by And. Thomsons land, thence S 80 E 41 ch. - condition-
 al line of P. land to Chestnut Conditional Corner on the N. side of s^d Creek
