State of South Carolina: Know all men by these Presents that I Philip Shurrell of Greenville district and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me paid by John Gilley of the district aforesaid have granted bargained sold conveyed released and confirmed and by these Presents do grant bargain sell release convey and confirm unto the said John Gilley a certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing by estimation one hundred and ^{thirty} ~~thirty~~ acres be the same more or less situate in Greenville district on both sides of Tyger river (the South fork) and runs as follows, viz, beginning at a Branch on Hardy Forresters line near a dead dogwood Corner, thence with the said line N. 40 E forty seven chains fifty links to a Spanish Oak, thence N 38 W. Sixteen chains to a Stake & pointer - thence S 57 W. fifty eight chains fifty links to a Stake David Forresters Corner, thence a Conditional line straight from said Stake to the head of the branch I began on thence down said branch to the beginning: Together with all and singular hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To the only use & behoof of him the said John Gilley his heirs and assigns forever. To have and to hold the aforesaid Premises with the appurtenances with out any interruption whatsoever and I do for myself my heirs executors & administrators warrant and force defend the above mentioned Premises to the said John Gilley his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs executors and Administrators, and all and every other person or Persons whomsoever claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof.
