Rec^d. of George W. Earle Five hundred and thirty dollars, it being in full payment for a Negro woman named Ally about twenty years of age, which I sold to the said Earle the fifteenth day of February last, and which has been in his possession since the eighteenth of said Month: and also in full for her two Children, to wit, One a Girl or female child about two years and half old of the name of Nancy; & the other a male child which the said Woman has had since she was sold and delivered by me to the said Earle.

All which said Negroes I do warrant to be sound healthy & sensible; and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend the said bargained Negroes & their Increase unto the said George W. Earle, his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs, and against every other person whomsoever claiming or to claim the said Negroes or any of their Increase. Witness my hand and seal this Twelfth day of April A.D. 1804. Signed sealed and delivered in the presence of J. Cleveland. Hardin Camp -
