

This Indenture made this Eleventh day of November one thousand seven hundred & ninety nine between David Lovell of the State of South Carolina & County of Greenville of the one part & John Billups of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the s^d David Lovell for the consideration of the sum of twenty four pounds to him in hand paid by the s^d John Billups the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and that the s^d David Lovell has granted bargained & sold unto the s^d John Billups part of a tract of land originally granted unto David Brown by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq: on the fourth day of December 1786 beginning upon a stake thence a Conditional line made by s^d Lovell & Billups to one of the head branches armstrongs creek down s^d Branch to where s^d Lovell's original line Corner s^d Branch the original line to a Spanish oak corner thence the original line to a stake on Joseph Williams line thence the original line to a White oak thence to the beginning corner it containing forty acres and that the s^d David Lovell will warrant and forever defend the above mentioned tract of land to the s^d John Billups his heirs & clear from me my heirs & from all and every person or persons whatsoever lawfully claims the same or any part thereof in witness thereof I have here unto set my hand and seal the day & date above mentioned signed sealed & delivered in the presence of us

This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of February one thousand eight hundred between John Billups of the one part of the State of South Carolina and Greenville ^{County} District and John Harrison of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Billups for and in ^{the} consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said John Harrison the receipt whereof is here by acknowledged & that the s^d John Billups have granted bargained & sold unto the said John Harrison part of two tracts of land lying on the south side of ruddy river it being part of two tracts of land one hundred acres originally granted to Joseph Box the twenty first day of January one thousand seven hundred & eighty five by his Excellency Benjamin Gerard Esq: Governor for him did give an grant unto Joseph Box a tract of land containing four hundred acres and forty acres of land lying and joining the same originally granted to David Brown by his Excellency W^m Moultrie Esq: on the fourth day of December one thousand seven hundred eighty six situate in the District of twenty six in the County of Greenville and both such forms and marks as appears by a plat to
