and Christian his wife of the State aforesaid in the District of Greenville, in consideration
of the sum of seven hundred & fifty dollars to us paid by Samuel Williams of the District
and State aforesaid have granted, bargained, sold & released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the s^d Samuel ~~Thomas~~ Williams a tract or parcel of
land lying in the District aforesaid at the mouth of the grave creek, beginning on a white oak
BX on Saluda river, thence North 20° E. 39. 96. White oak BX thence S. 70° E. 39. 54
to Stake BX thence S. 20° W. 63. 42. to Stake BX thence Nor. 65° W. to Quarry BX on
the river thence up the meanders of the said river to the beginning containing one hundred and
ninety acres originally granted to Lewis Gaffin by his Excellency W^m Moultrie on 1st day
of August 1795 reference being thereto had well more fully appeared also a small tract
lying on the side of the above tract beginning on a small hickory BX thence S. 70° E. 10
to a pine BX thence S. 20° W. 25. to a post oak BX thence N. 70° W. to a stake
BX thence to the beginning containing twenty five acres being the s^d Christians part
Dowry of a tract of land originally granted to Rodney Roark (Dumas?) Together with
all and singular the premises above mentioned with the right member Accretions and
appertinances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining
To have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the s^d Samuel
Williams his heirs and ^{assigns} forever and we do hereby bind our selves our heirs Executors and
Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the s^d premises
