

W^m Ferguson certain tract of land containing two hundred acres lying in the District
 & state aforesaid on a branch of Kichy creek of inorn river & hath such boundaries
 as it begins on stake corner running S. 80. W. 50. 00 to Stake corner thence N. 10
 W. 40. 00 to churnut corner thence N. 80. E. 50. 00 to stake corner from thence
 10. E. 40. 00 to the beginning corner the same being granted to Elias Brock by
 patent bearing date the 7th day of July 1788 and recorded in grant Book X
 X page 191 & conveyed from him to Moses Langley from Langley to the S^r David
 W Dade & from the S^r W Dade to William Ferguson together with all & singular
 the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the S^r premises belonging in any
 Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all & singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the S^r W^m Ferguson his heirs and assigns for ever & I do here
 by bind myself my heirs executors & assigns to warrant & forever defend all & singular
 the S^r premises unto the S^r William Ferguson his heirs & assigns against my
 self my heirs & against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming the same
 or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this 25th day of June in the year
 of our lord and in the 27th year of the Independence of the united States of America

This indenture made this fifth day of October in the year of our lord an thousand
 eight hundred & ninety five between Alexander Stevenson of Spartan County &
 State of South Carolina of the one part & William Young of Spartan high County
 & State aforesaid of the other witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of ten
 pounds Sterling money to him the S^r Alexander Stevenson in hand well & truly paid
 by the S^r William Young the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the Alexan
 der Stevenson hath bargained & sold assigned conveyed & confirmed & by these presents
 doth grant bargain sell convey & confirm unto the said William Young his heirs
 & assigns forever all that tract of land containing three hundred & forty four
 acres lying & being on both sides of the slick rock branch the waters of South pacolet
 river in the county of Greenville and state aforesaid immediately above a great
