

John Thomas Junr. of Greenville District in the State aforesaid in consideration
of the sum of Twelve hundred dollars to me paid by Patrick M'Dowall & John
Blair, otherwise, M'Dowall & Blair, of the City of Charleston in the State
aforesaid, have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant
bargain sell and release unto the said M'Dowall and Blair. All those Tracts
of Land, herein mentioned, to wit, One Tract of two hundred and fifty two acres
on which the said John Thomas now lives, together the Grist-mill, Saw-mill and
Cotton Machine thereon, originally granted granted to John Thomas Junr. and by
him conveyed to the said John Thomas Junr., fourteen acres a ball^u of a Tract
conveyed to me by Joseph O'Banion; a Balance not conveyed to any Person
of one thousand acres. Granted to me, containing by estimation two hundred
and Fifty acres, joining the Mill Tract aforesaid; Also one Tract of twenty two
acres joining the said Mill Tract, and on lands laid out for John Clement and
Arthur Stafford; and also one other Tract of Sixty Acres conveyed by William
D. Thomas to me, lying along the said Mill Tract, up the River to a line run
between the said William D. Thomas and myself — Being in the whole
Five hundred and Ninety-Eight Acres, more or less, together with
all and singular the Rights members hereditaments and Appurtenances
to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining:
To have and to hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto
the said M'Dowall and Blair aforesaid their Heirs & Assigns forever. And
I do hereby bind myself my Heirs Executors and Administrators, to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said Premises, unto the said
M'Dowall and Blair their Heirs and Assigns against myself & my Heirs
& against every Person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same
or any part thereof. Witness my hand and Seal this Second day of August
in the Year of Our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four and in
the twenty-ninth year of the Independence of the United States of America.
