Land being granted to Tennist Duff from the States office Beginning on a black Oak Corner 3<sup>rd</sup> thence N. 60 E 25 to a Stake thence N. 11 to a red Oak thence N 27. 2-10 to a Chestnut thence N 60 W. 15. 60 to a pine thence S. 60 W. 36-60 to a Stake thence S 40 E 30-20 to the beginning - Containing one hundred acres Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Lynch his heirs and assigns forever & and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators. To warrant and forever defende all and singular the said premises unto the said William Lynch his heirs or assigns against myself and my heirs and against every other Person. whomsoever Lawfully Claiming or to Claim the same or any part thereof - Witness my hands and seal this thirteenth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and four
