






Nothorn of the District aforesaid in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to me in  
hand paid by Cornelius Davis of the District aforesaid have bargained sold & released & by  
these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Cornelius Davis a plantation or tract  
of Land lying on both sides of Bush Creek including the plantation and tract of land contain-  
ing fifty acre by lines running N. E. N. W. by George Russel land on N. W. & N. E. by Isaac  
Guns beginning at a post Oak running S. W. W. 32 to a stake & S. 10 W. 8 from thence S. 30. 0. 0. m  
to white Oak from thence 50 along the Waggon road from thence to a hickory 0. m, from  
thence to George Russel corner 0. m, S. 0. 3. 0. m from thence on Russels line to the  
beginning - Together with all and singular the rights hereditaments & appertainances  
to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Cornelius  
Davis his heirs and assigns for ever and I do bind myself my heirs exec<sup>rs</sup> and admors  
to warrant and favor defend the said premises unto the said Davis his heirs and assigns  
forever against myself my heirs and against every other person or persons who shall  
by claiming the same or any part thereof. <sup>10</sup> In witness my hand and seal this 10<sup>th</sup>
