This indenture made this Thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one

 & State of South Carolina of the one part and William Johnson of the other part. Witnesseth
 that the said Wilkins for and in consideration of three hundred Dollars to him in hand paid
 by the s^r Wm Johnson the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged. Heath s^r &
 delivered unto the s^r Wm Johnson one tract or parcel of Land situate lying & being in s^c County
 the State of South Carolina including the plantation & premises whereon the s^r Wilkins now
 lives bounded as follows. Viz. beginning at a chestnut on or near W^d Edwards line thence S.
 19: E: to a small white Oak and branch thence up s^r branch to a post Oak thence to a stake
 Aquia on by Wilkins & Wood thence to a red Oak thence N: 60: E: to a red Oak same as Wilkins
 thence S. 60: E: 15: Ch. to a stake S. 22: W: 22: Ch. to a stake thence N: 60: E: 20: Ch. to a stake
 a line made between Edora Sumnerford & s^r Wilkins thence from said Chestnut to a pine corner
 thence to the Beginning. containing one hundred and fifty Acres both sides more
 or less. I bind myself my heirs Executors &c. to forever Warrant & defend the afore
 said land with all its rights & Interests unto the s^r Wm his heirs & assigns forever
