State of South Carolina & December 2<sup>nd</sup> 1804. I know all men by their  
 Greenville District & Presents that Mr John Ware of Livingston County  
 in Kentucky for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling  
 money to me in hand paid by Major Glatton of the State & District aforesaid - -

HAVE Grant bargain sold & Relas<sup>d</sup> and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell  
 Release unto Major Glatton a certain tract of lands lying on the North East side  
 of the Golden Grove Creek on the bearing Mill Creek Branch Beginning  
 on a popular Corner from thence S. W. down the main source of the stream  
 to a Chinquapin Corner at A Blackburns bridge from thence along the land S.  
 E. from thence up the Hollow to the waggon road by the meeting house to where John  
 Bowies line crosses the said road from thence along S. Bowies line N. E. State corner  
 from thence to a stone corner on the bearing mill branch, N. E. from thence S. W.  
 down the said branch to the fork from thence a condition all line marked out N. W.  
 to the beginning corner, two hundred acres more or less (Granted by his Excellency William  
 Muthies Esq<sup>r</sup> on the first day of May 1786) Together with all & singular the rights  
 Members Accretions appurtenances to the s<sup>d</sup> premises belonging or in any way incident  
 or appertaining, To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto  
 the s<sup>d</sup> Major Glatton his heirs & assigns forever - And I do hereby bin & myself my  
 heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and power defend all & singular the said premises  
 unto the said Major Glatton his heirs & assigns against myself self my heirs & every other  
 person lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof As Witness  
 my hand this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Dec<sup>r</sup> one thousand eight hundred & four signed & delivered in the presence  
 of William Wilson Obadiah <sup>mark</sup> Wood } - John Ware Esq<sup>r</sup> - - -
