 Beginning on a State marker at McCarlys line thence N. W. 52^o 15 on Funchus and
 Stensons line to a w. Oak 34 near along branch called Littletons branch thence S. W. 82^o 35 on
 A. Thur Clarks line to red O. 34 thence S. E. 84^o 10. 50 to area @ stump 34 on Joseph Archers line
 to P. O. 34 thence N. E. 25^o 5 to red O. 34 on McCarlys line on the S. E. side of Littletons branch
