field of the said State and district aforesaid have granted bargained sold and
Released, and by these Presents do Grant bargain sell and Release unto the
said J^eff^e Mayfield part of that tract or parcel of land lying and being on
the middle fork of Saluda River, granted unto me by his excellency William
Moultrie on the fourth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and eighty five, including the greatest part of the field now
in cultivation by said J^eff^e Mayfield, beginning upon a white oak com-
tree of my land, and upon Gowans line, thence up the river to a Hickory
