I know all men by their Presents that I Nathaniel Stokes of Spartan District for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and ten dollars to me in hand for a Negro girl aged between four and five years, Do bargain and sell unto Samuel James Alston his Executor Administrator and Assigns the above mentioned Negro girl which is now in the possession of the above mentioned Alston: to have and to hold her for ever without any claim by me or mine or any other person whomsoever I do warrant and defend by these Presents and I do therefore put the above Alston in full possession by delivering to him in these Presents Harriet the Negro Girl which is at this juncture bargained & paid for, Given under my hand and seal &c. this 8<sup>th</sup> of February 1805.

Have granted bargained & sold alienable, severable & confirmed by these presents Do for & in consideration of the sum of of two hundred dollars bargain & sell alien convey & confirm unto Charles Littleton all that tract or parcel of Land containing one hundred & thirty eight acres. Agreeable to a Grant in the name of Mark Littleton for the same one hundred & thirty eight acres of Land - Situate on the middle fork Saluda river - Together with all & singular this rights hereditaments & appurtenances to the same tract above mentioned belonging or in any wise appertaining To Have and To Hold the said granted premises to him the said Charles Littleton his heirs & assigns forever & I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> & Ad<sup>ors</sup> to warrant unto the said Charles Littleton his heirs & assigns from me & my heirs only the said above mentioned premises.
