Carolina Greenville District, Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Waldron of the State aforesaid & district of Carolina do in consideration of the sum of two hundred silver Dollars to me paid by Jesse Kirby of the District of Greenville Have granted bargained sold & released & By these presents do Grant bargain sell & release unto the sd Jesse Kirby all that part of a tract of land containing one hundred & twenty five acres Being part of a tract of land Originally granted unto Col^l Macks on Mountain Creek waters of Saddy river. This said tract Beginning near a Road on a post oak St thence N. 60. 33. 00. to a stake on the Original Line thence S. 40. E. 27. 00 to Stake St thence N. 58. E. 48. 50. to hickory St thence N. 40 W. 23. 50 Stake St on old line thence S. 52 W. 16. 50. to R. C. St old mark thence N. 85. W. 4. to the Beginning Corner P. O. St. Containing one hundred & twenty five acres More or less. Together with all & singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances the sd premises. Belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining To Have & to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the sd Jesse Kirby his heirs & assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & admors to Warrant & forever defend all & singular the said premises unto the sd Jesse Kirby his heirs & assigns Against myself my heirs & assigns and Against Every Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof

Likewise I Anna Waldron wife to sd Joseph Waldron do assign all my right and title of said above mentioned land unto the sd Jesse Kirby the same being for value rec^d.
