 dred acres (more or less) It being part of a tract of Land Granted Originally to
 Clayton Containing 872 acres bearing date the 1st day of July 1793 the aforesaid tract
 Containing two hundred acres (be the same more or less) Situate lying on Barnes branch
 the Waters of future Surveye between David Middle Sugar river in the said District of Greenville
 Beginning on a stake an Original Land corner of Clayton Survey thence along said line to a
 pine thence thence to a red Oak on the head of a branch that Joseph Coates lived on then
 down said branch to a Dogwood Corner in the Branch thence to a black Oak thence to a
 Chestnut on Barnes branch thence up said branch To the Beginning Stake Corner
