 Bargain & Release in by these presents do grant bargain & Release unto this said  
 Benjamin Barton a plantation tract of land lying in Greenville District, & State aforesaid  
 On both sides of the south fork of South Tiger River bound N.W. on land laid off to Mary Warner  
 all other sides Vacant Land. Beginning on a poplar running thus S. 30. E. 37. 20. to a Stake thence  
 N. 83. W. 27. to a red Oak thence N. 45. W. to a dogwood thence N. 80. W. 18. to a Chestnut thence  
 N. 19. to Hickory thence East 27. 50. to the Beginning corner, by Estimation ninety four acres  
 for the same ~~more or less~~, the same being a tract of land granted to William Davis & by said Davis  
 sold & conveyed to the said Mabray & now Mabray to said Barton. Together with all singular the  
 rights members hereditaments & appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any way  
 appertaining, To Have and To Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said  
 Benjamin Barton his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors  
 & Administrators to Warrant and power defende all & singular the said premises unto the  
 said Benjamin Barton his heirs & assigns forever ag<sup>t</sup> myself & my heirs & against all & every  
 Person Lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. . . . In Witness whereof
