Know all men by these presents that I Greshorn Kelly of Greenville County & State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred pound Lawfull Sterling Money to me in hand well & truly paid at & before the Sealing & Delivery of these presents by James Kelly of said County the Receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged I have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents Doth Grant bargain & sell & Consign unto the said James Kelly him his heirs & assigns forever the following Property Viz. Seven negro Slaves first a negro woman about seventeen years old, second a negro woman about sixteen years old, third a negro boy named Feast about twelve years old, fourth a negro boy named Ned about ten years old, fifth a negro girl named Elze about ten years old, sixth a negro girl named Luger about five years old, seventh a negro girl named Grace about five years old, also seven feather beds, Together with forty head of Cattle together with three Sorel Horses two grey mares also one bay mare also one dark brown mare, Together with all & singular the above mentioned premises unto him the said James Kelly him his heirs & assigns forever, I the said Greshorn Kelly shall & will against the legal claim of all & every person or persons whatsoever warrant & power depend - As witness my hand & to the same I have hereunto set my hand & seal this Eighteenth day of April one thousand Seven hundred & ninety four.

Ewardly the old line to a marker
