Elkins now his on and runs as follows Beginning on a and one oak on the south side of South Tygar river Thence South fifty five degrees West Eight chains to a post oak Thence North thirteen degrees West nine chains to a maple on the edge of a lake Thence with said lake to the River including the Island Thence down the River to the Beginning - Containing eight acres by the same more or less - Together with all & singular Rights members tenements & appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Salmon his heirs and assigns forever - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators to warrants and forever defende all & singular the said premises - unto the said George Salmon his heirs & assigns against myself and my heirs and against all & every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal the first day of May one Thousand Eight hundred and five - Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence of - W.
