 unto Enoch Hooper the other sides on vacant land at the line of the survey which said tract  
 of land was surveyed for Louisa Bridges the 13<sup>th</sup> of Oct: 1784. and elapsed by Peter Ferman  
 and Francis Brumar on the first of March 1786. & Granted to them the 6<sup>th</sup> of March 1786  
 under the hand and seal of William Moultrie Esq: Governor at that time and by the said Ferman  
 and Brumar conveyed unto the said Mazy S. Smith. Together with all and singular the rights  
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise
