Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise appertaining - To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John Lucas his heirs Executors administrators and assigns for ever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to Warrant and forever defend from all and Every person or persons Claiming or to claim Lawfully any parcel or part thereof -

Personally appeared William Garbrough of the State and District aforesaid - and made Oath that he saw the within named Joab Hails sign his seal and Deliver the within deed of Conveyance to the within named John Lucas for all the purposes therein mentioned and that he at the same time saw the Under named James Jackson sign his name as a subscribing Witness thereto and he this deponent signed his name then also as a subscribing Witness - Proves before me this the 4<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord 1805 - Obediah Woodson J. 2.
