The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Thomas Beale of Botetourt County & State of Virginia, attorney de facto for Mary & William Bushby of the City of Washington and District of Columbia For and in Consideration of five hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Benjamin Harris of Greenville District in the State of South Carolina Have granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Benjamin Harris all that tract or parcel of Land containing Five hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying & being in the District and State last aforesaid on Saluda River being originally granted to Mary Manning now Mary Bushby, as one of the Heirs of Jacob Hite deceased, Beginning on a Beach on Saluda River thence N. 49. E. 44. 75 to a B. Oak st thence N. 74. E. 16. 40. to a stake thence S. 82. W. 41. 46. to a hickory corner thence N. 6. W. 46. 50 to a stake thence S. 65. W. 68. 50 to a white Oak thence S. 70. W. 2. Chains to a pine on the river, thence down the meanders of said Saluda river to the Beginning, Together with all & singular the rights members & incidents and appurtenances to the said premises. belonging or in any wise incident or appurtenant. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Harris his heirs & assigns forever. And I do hereby (as attorney aforesaid) bind the said Mary & William Bushby, their heirs Executors & Administrators. to warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Benjamin Harris his heirs and assigns against myself themselves their Heirs Executors & Administrators & against any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
