The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I George Saunders of Greenville District State aforesaid for & in consideration of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Wilson of the state & District aforesaid I have granted Bargain & Sold and by these presents Do Grant bargain sell & Release unto the said John Wilson his heirs & assigns forever all that tract of two hundred acres of land it Being a part of a Survey granted said Saunders by Patton Bearing Date Situate in the State & District aforesaid Beginning at post oak S. 55. E. 45. Chains to a Stake + 3 thence N. 30. 42. E. by 50 links to a Spanish Oak. thence N. 60. W. 61. Chains 50 links running with J. Flits to a stake thence S. 44. 6. to a post oak, which includes the full Lands to be conveyed. Together with all singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances thunto belonging or in any wise incident to the same - to have & to hold all singular the premises aforesaid unto the said John Wilson his heirs Executors administrators & assigns forever, & I do hereby bind myself my heirs & c. to warrant & favor defend all singular the said premises unto the said John Wilson his heirs & assigns forever against myself my heirs & c. & against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 3rd day of July 1806. And in the 30th year of the Independance of the united States of America - Signed sealed & Delivered in
