The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that I Benjamin Townsen of Greenville District & State aforesaid in Consideration of one hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Ninimon Mullican of the State & District aforesaid Have granted bargained sold & Released and by these Presents Do Grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Ninimon Mullican a plantation or tract of land containing one hundred acres, (or the same more or less) Situate in Greenville District lying on Little horse Creek Beginning on a beach 34 on said creek Running thence S. 20. W. 55 to post oak 34 bounding on Wm Lees land thence N. 57. E. 15. 75 to a Stake 34 Bounding on Samuel Neighboures land thence N. 65. E. 8. to a Stake 34 Bounding on William Browns thence N. 5. E. 18. to a white Oak 34 Bounding on Benja. Pristers lands thence N. 30. E. 35. 50 down the meanders of a branch to its Confluence with Little horse creek thence up the meanders of said creek to the Beginning, Being part of a tract of 514 acres of lands originally granted to Henrick Arnolds on the 14th day of June 1790 and by different conveyances conveyed to the said Benja. Townsen, Together with all and singular the rights members her detaiments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Ninimon Mullican to him & his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend full and singular the said premises unto the said Ninimon Mullican to him his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
