South Carolina Greenville District 3 Know all men by these presents that William Tinsley of the District and State afores^d for and in considerations of one hundred and Twelve Dollars paid by Elinor Vernon (Widow) of the District and State afores^d Have granted bargained sold Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the s^d Elinor Vernon a certain tract or parcel of lands containing Sixty two acres situated in Greenville District on the West side of Reedy River Bounded by a line, Beginning on the East side of s^d River on Red Oak St. running S.W. along Jo^s Boaz lands to white Oak St. thence S.E. to a post Oak thence S.W. to post Oak on Lovells land thence along Hairthorn line N.E. crossing s^d River to white Oak St. thence up s^d River to the Beginning, and originally granted to William Norris and from him to s^d Wm Tinsley, Together with all and singular the premises before mentioned and Released unto the s^d Elinor Vernon her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Assignors To warrant and forever defend all & singular the premises unto the s^d Elinor Vernon her heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hands and seal this 20th day of August in the year of our Lords, one Thousand Eight hundred and four & Twenty Eighth year of American Independance
