State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Michael
 McLevraeth of Spartanburg District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of
 the sum of Two hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Archibald Taylor of Greenville
 District. The Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Have granted and sold and by
 these Presents do grant sell and Release convey & confirm unto the said Archibald Taylor
 all that tract and Parcel of lands containing one hundred and ninety Eight Acres
 more or less. Situate in Greenville District in the State aforesaid on the small branch
 of Muske creek waters of Tygar River bounded to the North by John Nicols lands all
 other sides vacant lands having such shapes forms and marks as are represented
 by a plat therunto annexed being granted unto Samuel Brice Anno: Domini:
 in the year of our Lords one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven. To have &
 to hold unto the said Archibald Taylor his heirs and assigns forever. & I the said
 Michael McLevraeth for myself my heirs and assigns forever defende against myself
 my heirs and assigns from all claims or claimers that shall come against the said
 Archibald Taylor. In Witness whereunto set my hand and affix my seal this
 twenty fifth day of Nov^r: Eighteen hundred and five.
