Know all men by these Presents that I John Lucas of the State aforesaid & District of Greenville in Comianation of the sum of one hundred dollar to me in hand paid by William Nelson of the district and State aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold Released and by these Presents do bargain sell and Release unto the said William Nelson all that tract or Parcel of land being in the district of Greenville on wild cat creek of South Tigar river. Beginning on a Stake in said creek on a conditional line made between William Tubb and the said William Nelson running East on the Conditional line to a red oak thence S^o to a white oak a conditional corner thence on conditional line made between the S^o Nelson and W^m Tubb to the heads of a branch thence down the meanders of said Branch to the said creek thence up said creek to the beginning corner. Lying on the E^t side of S^o Creek and on the north side of said branch containing thirty acres be the same more or less the same being part of a tract of land granted to John Lucas by His Excellency Ben^g Lurard bearing date June 25th one thousand seven hundred & eighty five, with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenments to S^o Premises belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Nelson his heirs and assigns forever - AND I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the S^o Premises to the said William Nelson his heirs & assigns against myself my heirs and against every person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof - In Witness whereof I have hereunto my hands and seal this 20th day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and five and in the twenty ninth of American Independence - Signed Sealed and Delivered in the Presence of 14
