Carolina for & in consideration of the true & full sum of forty Dollars to him in hand paid by John  
Sammon of the same Dist. & State afores<sup>d</sup> the Receipt whereof he the said William Sinsley  
doth hereby acknowledge. Hath bargained sold released & confirmed unto the said  
Sammon his heirs & assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying &  
being in the district afores<sup>d</sup> on the waters of Reedy River containing twenty acres more or  
less & bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on a hickory on Sammons line thence  
Sammon line S<sup>2</sup> to a hickory corner on W<sup>m</sup> Duncans line thence W<sup>2</sup> to a branch  
thence down the branch as its meanders to a hickory & chestnut corner thence a new  
line N<sup>2</sup> to the beginning. To have and to hold the above sold land & premises with  
all and singular the priviledges and appurtenances therunto belonging & in any  
wise appertaining to him the said Sammon his heirs and assigns forever to the only  
proper use and behoof him the said John Sammon his heirs and assigns  
forever John hold use occupy possess & enjoy the same with every part thereof  
to him the said Sammon his heirs and assigns forever against any claim or demand  
of me or my heirs or against the lawful claim of any other person whatsoever -  
I shall do & will warrant & forward defend. In witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this Eleventh day of November Eighteen hundred
