The State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I John Nations of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by William Shackston Senr of the State and District aforesaid I have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do Grant bargain and sell unto William Shackston all and every part of that tract or parcel of land containing Two hundred and thirty five Acres Surveyed for Jacob Davis and granted to him October the 30th day 1780 be the same more or less - Situate in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of horse pen creek and bounded by Steven Howard, Solomon Hays, Henry Stokes & William Rice Sands, Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise Incident or appertaining: Thence unto to the only proper use and behoof of him the said William Shackston his heirs and assigns forever: and the said John Nations doth hereby bind himself his heirs Executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and every singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said William Shackston, his heirs Executors admors & assigns forever, against himself and his heirs Exec^{rs} and admors and against every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
