To all people unto whom this present writing shall come, I William Grant of the State of South Carolina and Greenville district, send Greeting: Know ye that I the said William Grant for divers good causes & valuable considerations me thereunto moving with the love good will and affections I bear unto my seven

Children hereafter named, have given granted and confirmed unto my above seven children (viz) John Foster Grant, Nancy Grant, Ruben Hackett Grant, Elizabeth M. Wharter Grant, Mary Hendley Grant, George Washington Green Grant, Marshall Jefferson Grant. Seven Negroes and their further increase of the females, (viz) Sam. Vance, Peter, Ned, Little Peter, Selby & Sibby, unto the above named children their heirs or heirs forever, freely peaceably & quietly, without any manner of let trouble, or denial, of me the said W. Grant, further than reserving unto myself the labour of the said Negroes during the time of my natural life, at which period to be equally divided amongst the above seven children, agreeable to valuation, all which property I the above named William Grant, doth give & confirm unto the above children for them, heirs and assigns to enjoy forever, In Witness hereof, I do hereby set my hand & seal, Twenty Eight of May, in the year of Christ, one thousand eight hundred and six, and the third of American Independence, In presence of us

Have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto Josiah Thompson of the district and state aforesaid, all that tract of land, situate lying & being on the Golden Grove creek in the district of Greenville aforesaid containing by the plat annexed to the Original Patent, six hundred acres, be the same more or less, bounded on the south East by land laid out to John M. Devereux esquire, & granted to Nathaniel Pennington by Grant from the State of South Carolina, dated the sixteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty four, Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold all & singular the premises before mentioned to the said Josiah Thompson his heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and administrators, to warrant & defend
