Have Granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do bargain sell & release unto the said Reuben Master a certain tract or parcel of land containing four hundred acres be the same more or less. Situated in the State and district aforesaid including Armstrongs creek about one mile it being a part of four tracts of land one originally granted to William Master one granted to Nicholas Darnall one to Thomas Young one to Obadiah Hooper. Beginning on a post oak on W^m. Southern's line thence down said line to Southern Spring branch thence said line to the next branch thence down said branch to a white oak then a conditional line between said Master and Elias Earle to a red oak on the bank of Armstrongs creek thence the conditional line to a red oak near the old ridge road thence to a Stake in Thomas Young's line thence the original line to a white oak corner, thence Nicholas Darnall's line to the creek thence up said creek to a conditional line made between said Darnall & Abraham Bradley thence said line to a conditional line between said Blackwell & James Timley thence said line to the road thence to the Beginning - Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said land belonging or in any wise incident appertaining.
