for the Premises hereinafter described and for and in consideration of the sum of Eight
hundred and twenty two dollars and forty cents to us in hand paid by the Honorable
Waddy Thompson Esquire of the State aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and
released. and by these presents Do grant, bargain, sell and Release, unto the said Waddy
Thompson. All that tract, piece, or parcel of land which was granted in fee simple
by letters Patent under the great seal of the State on the thirteenth day of April in the
Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six. to the said John Huger Esquire
Containing one thousand two hundred and eighty acres more or less situated in the district
of Ninety Six on the waters of the Saluda and the Golden Grove having such shape
form marks description buttins and bounding as are delineated and represented in a
plat or resurvey thereof by William Butchard Deputy Surveyor on the thirtieth day of
May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety Nine annexed to
these presents and co-inciding with plat annexed to the original Grant. Together with
all and singular the rights members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises
belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular
the Premises before mentioned unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns forever. And
we do hereby bind ourselves, our Heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all
and singular the said Premises unto the said Waddy Thompson his heirs and assigns. Against
