Witnesseth that the said John Laws for and in consideration of the sum of ten dollars to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Linn the receipt whereof the said John Laws doth acknowledge and himself fully satisfied, hath granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the sd, Thomas Linn a certain tract of land containing fifty acres more or less beginning at a Red oak thence along & old path to the creek thence down the creek to silversides old line thence along the sd, silversides line to a poplar & from thence to the beginning Red oak being part of a tract land laid out by W^m Russell to have & to hold & every part thereof to the sd, Thom's Linn & the sd John Laws doth for him self & his heirs & from all & every other person or persons warrant the sd, land unto Thomas Linn & to his heirs forever in witness whereunto the sd, John Laws hath set his hand & seal the day & year above written - Rich and Simmons } personally came before me
