Have granted bargained sold and Released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & Release unto the said Strawder Shumate all that plantation or tract of land containing three hundred and Sixty acres (be the same more or less) Situate in the District aforesaid. lying on the branches of horse creek waters of Needy River. Beginning on a oak 34 running thence N. 80. W. 69. 00 to a Stake 3x bounding on Thomas Mullicans land thence N. 10. E. 44. 50 to a Stake 3x bounding on Jonathan Dewees thence N. 5. E. 7. 50. to a Stake 3x bounding on Mrs Devoyport thence S. 85. E. 82. 50. to a Hickory 3x bounding on Aults Sullivan's thence S. 6 W. 8. 00 to a Hickory 3x thence S. 20. W. 19. 50 to a Post oak 3x thence S. 65. E. 10. 50 to a Hickory 3x. the last mentioned lines bounds on William M. Culla thence S. 10. W. 19. 50 to the Beginning, bounding on John Handlers land. Together with all and singular the Rights members Hereditaments and appurtenances unto the said Premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining. To Have and to Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Strawder Shumate his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all & singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said Strawder Shumate his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against all persons whomsoever Lawfully Claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof; - Witness my hand and seal this 26. day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and seven. & in the thirty first year of the Independence of the United States of America?
