of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seven, And thirtyfirst year of

Johnson of Greenville District, in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of
one hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid by William Johnson of the State and
District aforesaid, I have granted bargained and sold unto the said William Johnson
all that tract or parcel of land, supposed to contain one hundred acres - be the same
more or less, it being a part of a tract of two hundred and fifty acres originally granted to
Hannah Johnson by Patent bearing date the 5th day of Sep^r 1785. & recorded in Grant
book E.E.E. page 327, including all that land, included in said original survey
of two 250 acry as aforesaid, except that part which I have hitherto conveyed unto the said
William Johnson by a deed bearing date the 24th day of January 1795. Situate in the State
and district on the Sth side of Guilders Creek Waters of Enore river, including the plantation
whereon the said Hannah Johnson now lives bounded on the N^o by James Kilgore land,
on the E^o by John Westmoreland & on the S^o & W^o by said William Johnsons land,
Together with all and singular the rights members Hereditaments & appurtenances
thereunto belonging or in any wise Incident thereunto - And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
Executors & adm^rs to warrant and forever defend all & singular the Premises above menti.
