And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and adm<sup>rs</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the Premises above mentioned unto the said Abraham Smith his heirs Executors adm<sup>rs</sup> and assigns forever, against myself my heirs, Executors and adm<sup>rs</sup> and against every other Person or Persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof -

Know all men by these Presents that I Lyn Walker of Greenville District in the State aforesaid, in Consideration of Five hundred Dollars to me paid by Abraham Smith of the District and State aforesaid - Have granted bargained sold & Released and by these Presents Do grant bargain sell and Release unto said Abraham Smith a certain Plantation a tract of land, containing one hundred and fifty acres more or less. Lying in the District and State aforesaid, on Rocky Creek of Enoree River, and hath such boundaries. Whereas it Beginning at a Spanish oak corner originally P. Hudsons from thence a straight Conditional line between S. Walker and A. Smith across Rocky Creek to a Spanish oak Station thence a Conditional line to a maple corner, on the South side of a certain branch of Rocky Creek thence up the said branch to S. Walkers line from thence along S. line to a pine corner from thence to a Stake corner, from thence to an ash corner, from thence across Rocky Creek to a Spanish oak corner from thence up the said Creek to a Conditional Gum corner made between Lyn Walker and Lewis Pector from thence a Conditional line to a black oak corner, from thence to a Conditional red oak corner from thence a Conditional line to a pine corner, from thence to the beginning Spanish oak corner, it being parts of tracts of lands originally granted to Joseph Woodall P. Hudson W. Tiller and S. Walker - Together with all and singular the rights, members, Hereditaments, and appurtenances to the S. Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining - To Have and To Hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Abraham Smith his heirs and assigns forever - and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exec<sup>rs</sup> & adm<sup>rs</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the s<sup>d</sup> Abraham Smith his heirs & assigns against myself & my heirs and against every Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim
